Welcome to our exciting new 100 CLUB – a great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works...

What is a 100 Club?

A 100 Club is a form of private lottery. Participants buy numbered tickets which are entered into a regular draw, e.g. 100 tickets for a 100 Club. Parents, teachers and friends of the school pay a fixed subscription for their number/s. When the tickets are drawn, a percentage of the profit is given as the prize, with the remainder going to PTA funds.

What will we raise and what could I win?

The prize money will be 35% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 65% goes to the PTA to help fund equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils. So, for a full 100 club we will take £500 income per month and we will award following prizes each month:

1st prize - £100

2nd prize - £50

3rd prize - £25.

The remaining £325 is profit for the PTA. This every month! Which means each year we could raise up to £3900!

How do I join?

You complete and sign the attached sign up form and Standing Order mandate for £5 a month or you can pay for the full year by cheque (£60). Drop this into Manjit in the school office.

This buys you one membership number (we will allocate), which enters you into the monthly draw. All participants must be over 16 (this is grown up fun!).

The draw will take place in school on the last Friday of each month. The first draw will be in January 2018 so to be a part of it sign up now.

100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES

1. For a cost of £5 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 35% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 20%, 2nd prize of 10% and 3rd prize of 5%.
5. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Brodetsky Jewish Primary School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
7. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
10. The draw shall be made by the Head Teacher or her representative on the last Friday of each month.
11. July's draw will be made on the last Friday of the summer term.
12. August's draw will be made on the first Friday of the autumn term.
13. The winners will be contacted by a member of The Link within one week of the draw.
14. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on Parentmail and on the school website.
15. The 100 Club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
16. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
17. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTA funds after six months.
