

## **Parent Consultation Outcome**

In July 2016 just before we broke up for the Summer holidays, we consulted with the majority of our families in order to gain their views about different aspects of school. Please see the results of the consultation below.


1. The school report was informative about how my child is doing at school.



2. I feel that the school provides the right amount of homework.




## 3. I feel homework should be OPTIONAL/COMPULSORY




4. What changes would you like to see in our Homework provision?

We had varying responses to this question ranging between parents wanting weekly, marked homework sheets to parents wanting more practical- based homework that can be completed as a family. Based on the range of preferences parents have expressed, we will be exploring this further and working with Governors to review our Homework Policy. 
5. Behaviour at Brodetsky is good.

8. What changes would you like to see in our Behaviour System?

There were varying responses to this but not a clear trend. Based on how well the Planners are working in keeping Parents informed about children's behaviour in school we have introduced them from Year 3 this year.

Please provide us with any positive feedback about what has worked well this year.

Thank you for all of the comments about what has worked well in school. There were lots of individual responses but the small themes that came out were:

- ✓ The encouragement and creativity shown in Early Years (5 responses)
- ✓ Mr Y's personal communication! (6 responses)
- ✓ Forest School visits (4 responses)
- ✓ Growth Mindset (8 responses)
- ✓ Behaviour system (9 responses)
- √ Homework (8 responses)
- ✓ Children making good progress (10 responses)
- √ Happy Children (7 responses)
- ✓ ...and to quote one parent 'a very positive, warm, supportive environment through school.'

## 9. Please let us know what has not worked so well.

Thank you for sharing with us what has not worked so well for you. There were individual responses based on personal experiences but please see the small themes that came up and what we are doing about these:

- Homework (8 responses)
   Based on the consultation this is under further review.
- Based on the consultation this is under further review. > Communication (9 responses)
  - We are continuously trying to improve our communication system and rely on Parents to read Parentmail and check the website for information.
- Parents' Evening timings (5 responses)
  There are mixed views from teachers and parents about when these should be held so this year we will be bringing forward the July Parents' Evenings to the Spring Term to see if these work better for us all.
- Food menu (5 responses)

  We have had a new menu since September and the majority of children seem to be enjoying it. Children in Reception and Key Stage 1 are offered free school lunches and most of them have taken this up.

Thank you for all of your feedback. Your views are important to us and will help inform our provision. Please keep in touch with us and let us know directly when things are not working so well as usually a face to face conversation, telephone call or e-mail with school will resolve issues or clarify any queries.
